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The RAP consortium is happy to announce that the **RAP POWER DYNAMICS WORKBOOK** is available.

The **RAP Workbook** contents, materials and processes help youth professionals to reflect upon their position of power and establish accountable relationships with their young clients where the youth worker is clear about his/her role in the power structure, what the scope of the mandate is and what mutual obligations flow from the relationship. This, in turn, invites young people to become active members of the relationship and consequently enhances their personal responsibility and promotes their personal autonomy.




The workbook is available in English, French, Italian and Spanish.

The workbook drills into 9 key concepts related to youth work and describes these from both the current youth work perspective as well as from the perspective related to power dynamics, and provide a practice which the youth professional can use (for themselves or with their clients) to interact on the concept explained.

The 9 RAP concepts

Trust, Communication, Attention to language, Responsibility, Consistency, Listening, Safe environment, Reflecting on the roles, Collaboration
